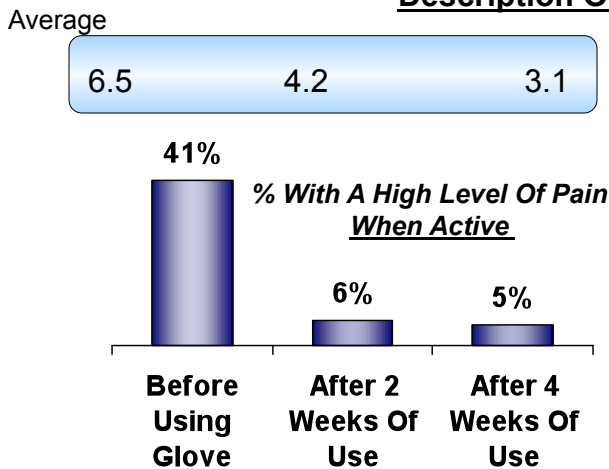


Therapeutic Glove Quantitative Research

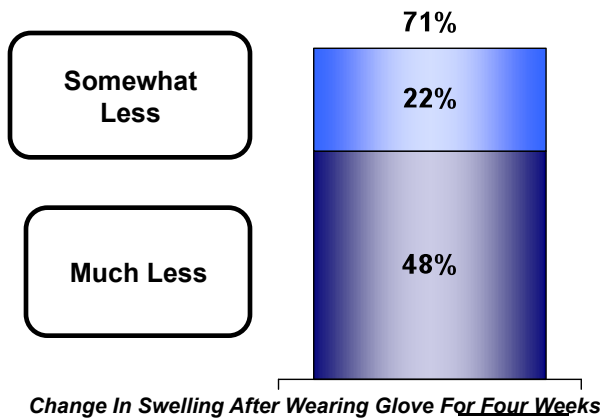
Patients were studied over a four week period to test pain and swelling relief as well as fit, comfort and ease of use. Overwhelmingly patients experienced less pain and swelling both at two and four week intervals. Those participating in the study were post surgical or suffering from Arthritis, injury or repetitive motion/carpal tunnel.

Description Of Pain After Using Glove



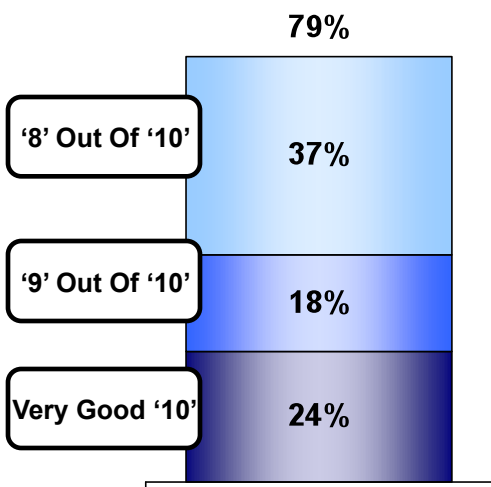
When active or when resting, it appears the therapeutic glove successfully decreases the level of pain experienced by respondents after two weeks and seemingly further after four weeks of use.

Impact Of Glove On Level Of Swelling



In addition to pain improvements, the glove also appears to successfully decrease the level of swelling in the hand; especially the longer the glove is used.

Overall Rating Of Glove



The vast majority of respondents provide a favorable overall rating of the glove, mostly due to the relief of swelling and pain the glove provided, and for providing a secure, comfortable feeling.
